The present committee of Malayali Association officially assumed charges on 24th March 2019 during the AGM held at Sitra Biru, Kuala Belait.

The committee has met 10 times for monthly meetings with an average attendance of 60%. In addition to the Management Committee, subcommittee members were also invited from the MA members, aimed to provide a platform for the community to work with the Management Committee in certain areas.

A lot of activities and programmes were organised under the banner of Malayali Association. The number of memberships has become 140 in 2019.

The trees and bushes along their perimeter fences were cleaned up and the Main gate of the compound was repaired. The event was finished with a lunch with the inmates.

Free Medical Camp

25th August 2019

This program was one of the key events in Welfare committee diary this year. MA could support working community to do a free medical checkup with doctor's consultation. Blood pressure, Blood Sugar and Cholesterol were checked for all participants. Medical talks on the most relevant health issues were also provided as a part of the program.

Excellent support from the Indian Doctors under Dr Dileep from KB Hospital was the key to the success of this program.

This was first of its kind by MA and it was a grand success in terms of participation and feedback we received.

Welfare Donation

As part of the association's welfare commitment to local community, it also donated BND\$500 each to Belait District's Orphans Fund, SMARTER Brunei & Eric Goh.
